Q- Many of these items appear to be capital expenditures. Why is King of Glory having a campaign focused on giving on one particular Sunday versus a more traditional Capital Campaign?

A - The Council and King of Glory Generosity team are sensitive to the fact that we have had a somewhat recent Capital Campaign that ran from 2014-16, with some members extending their pledge a 4th year. In addition, we believe based on the outlined needs in the brochure, we can achieve our goals via a Miracle Offering Sunday rather than a multi-year effort of a Capital Campaign.

Q- What happens if we don't reach the \$900,000 giving goal on Miracle Offering Sunday?

A-The King of Glory Church Council will meet to propose what capital improvements should have the highest priority and allocate funds appropriately. They will also have a timeline and funding plan for improvements that are needed but can't be funded via the Miracle Offering gifts.

Q- Hasn't King of Glory been working on a strategic plan for years? Why do we now need to hire a consultant to finalize and implement?

A – Our Mission, Values & Vision clearly define who we are and more importantly, what God is calling us to do. Thorough implementation of any vision for mission is absolutely essential. However, implementation is often the most challenging, and most often unfinished, part of many congregations' future planning work. KOG's consultant will work with us to create a detailed implementation plan with specific objectives, responsibilities, timelines and outcomes.

Q- What new programs or ministries will King of Glory have as a result of the Miracle Offerings?

A - KOG's consultant will work with us to create a ministry vision plan that is strategic, measarable, and achievable. Vision Planning is about bringing focus to King of Glory's vision in order to develop and launch new ministries and programs that impact our congregation and community. The enhancements to our facility will be tools for future ministry development.

Q- How will the funds from the recent sale of the rental house be used?

A- Miracle Offering Sunday is focused on making immediate improvements to enhance our facilities in ways that will enhance our Mission, Values & Vision Plan. There are additional capital improvements and maintenance items needed which are even beyond scope of the Miracle offering Sunday funds which will need to be addressed in the coming months.

Q-Do I/we need to give our donation on Miracle Offering Sunday or can we extend our giving beyond September 26?

A - We anticipate that the majority of the gifts will be made September 26 and the days following. However, members or households who prefer to give their gift over a few months are welcome to do so.
